3. In your 3-paragraph letter:
 - a. In your first paragraph, say that you are supporting Diane Snelling for Vermont Senate.
 - b. In the second paragraph, write 1 or 2 short sentences about why you support Diane. Some reasons you might want to use are below, and feel free to add your own!
 - c. In the last paragraph, encourage readers to support Diane and to learn more about her by visiting www.dianesnelling.com.
4. Keep your entire letter to no more than 250-300 words –3 short paragraphs.
5. Be sure to include your:
 - a. Full name
 - b. Town
 - c. Phone Number and Email Address
